This Agreement Made the 20th day of February 1846
between Williams Williams of the one part & Margaret
Williams of the other part witnesseth, That whereas
at the request of Said Williams Williams & the Said
Margaret who is his daughter in law came to his house
to reside with him in character of Housekeeper & Manager
of his family affairs on Oct 1st 1832 for the annual
Compensation of one hundred dollars to be paid to her
for her services at the end of each year, and whereas
the sum of money hitherto been paid to her
and the said Margaret yet continued to reside with him
& act as housekeeper & manager as aforesaid - and
whereas it is right & proper that said Margaret should
be compensated for her trouble & labour which is
incessant and fatiguing - Now therefore let it known
that the said William Williams do hereby agree to pay
to her the said Margaret the full amount due to her for
arrearages as hire as aforesaid to this date being the
sum of six hundred fifty six dollars Ninety Six cents
(\$656.96) - and I also agree with her to continue to pay
to her at the same rate of one hundred dollars yearly
during the time she may continue to remain with me
as housekeeper as aforesaid, and it is distinctly understood
that this allowance is over and above & in addition to
her sustenance & boarding for which the said William
Williams made no charge - & it witnesseth whereof
& the said William Williams have hereunto set their
hands the date above written County February 20th 1846
